SUNDAY LITURGY

1st Reading: Exodus 19:2-6a; 2nd Reading Romans 5:6-11

Theme: Persecution

This is the theme that binds together the three readings. The light of God disturbs those who prefer to live in darkness and they inevitably react by opposition. Persecution often troubled the lives of the prophets. The first reading reminds us of the prophet Jeremiah. In the gospel Jesus says that persecution is a kind of cloak that his disciples will have to wear if they are to be firm in their beliefs. The second reading compares Adam with Christ and confirms that in the struggle between good and evil, good will always triumph.

Response to the Psalm: We are his people, the sheep of his flock.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia.

The kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel. **Alleluia.**

When our new priests arrived in the Spring we published the future need for volunteers to help with various ministries and events. We are now asking for people to volunteer for the following ministries at the Mass which they regularly attend. Training will be given in all cases and rotas will be provided so that people know when they are expected to minister. Routinely, when we ask for volunteers for ministries, people will say "I am not worthy to do". Please be sure that none of us consider ourselves worthy but we serve our ministry because Jesus needs us to. These ministries are: Welcomer (before Mass at the back of the church) Reader (first or second reading at Mass), Offertory gifts (bringing the dish of altar breads and the chalice of wine from the back of the church to the sanctuary), Offertory collection (passing the money bags to the people from bench to bench and bringing the bags to the sanctuary) and finally Eucharistic Ministry (helping to distribute the blessed sacrament in the form of bread or wine to the people as they come to receive the Most Holy Sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ). **Please pray and consider which ministry you might help with.**
