SUNDAY LITURGY

1st Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a; 2nd Reading 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

Theme: Take and Eat

All the three readings today help us to reflect on the meaning of the Eucharist. The first speaks of manna, an unexpected gift of God, that gave life to the people of Israel during their stay in the desert. The gospel presents a gift immensely superior to manna, it is the bread that gives eternal life. To eat such bread means to want to be identified with Christ. The second reading tells us that the Eucharist is not bread to be eaten alone. It is broken and shared as a means and sign of unity.

Response to the Psalm: O Jerusalem, glorify the Lord!

Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia.

I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord.

If anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever.

Alleluia.

When our new priests arrived in the Spring we published the future need for volunteers to help with various ministries and events. We are now asking for people to volunteer for the following ministries at the Mass which they regularly attend. Training will be given in all cases and rotas will be provided so that people know when they are expected to minister. Routinely, when we ask for volunteers for ministries, people will say "I am not worthy to do". Please be sure that none of us consider ourselves worthy but we serve our ministry because Jesus needs us to. These ministries are: Church cleaners, welcomers (before Mass at the back of the church) Reader (first or second reading at Mass), Offertory gifts (bringing the dish of altar breads and the chalice of wine from the back of the church to the sanctuary), Offertory collection (passing the money bags to the people from bench to bench and bringing the bags to the sanctuary) and finally ministers of communion (helping to distribute the blessed sacrament in the form of bread or wine to the people as they come to receive the Most Holy Sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ). **Please pray and consider which ministry you might help with and sign up at the back of the church for the Mass you attend.**
