SUNDAY LITURGY

1st Reading: 1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a, 2nd Reading: Romans 9:1-5, Gospel: Matthew 14:22-33.

Theme: Revelation of God and the Revelation of Christ

The first reading and the gospel have the same theme, the revelation of the face of God. In the first reading Yahweh manifests himself to Elijah in a completely new way, different from the pagan gods and from the way to which Israel was accustomed. In the gospel we have a further revelation of God, through Jesus who comes, like the God of Old Testament, as master of the sea, giving his own divine power to humans.

In 2013 Jerome Hunt, a local professional painter, produced a picture of the west front of Peterborough Cathedral. It is a striking piece of work, painted at a time when the sun is closer to the horizon and the shadows of the three Gothic arches give the picture a tremendous sense of 3 dimensionality. It could be compared with paintings of the west front of Rouen Cathedral by Claude Monet during 1892-1893. The size of the painting is 33cm by 35cm and it has been expertly framed, so the painting has the appearance of a much larger work. It would look magnificent on the wall of a family home. We are selling tickets at £5 each to give someone a chance to win this one-off piece of local history.
