### SUNDAY LITURGY

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Ezekiel 33:7-9; 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: Romans 13:8-10; Gospel: Matthew 18:15-20**

**Theme: How to Correct a Person.**

We should all think only about ourselves. Is this correct? No, because, as all readings today tell us, we are responsible for each other. The first reading explains the idea with the story of the sentry who is expected to blow his horn when he sees danger. The gospel suggests how to correct one who has strayed from the way. The second reading complements this theme because it presents love for the other person as the rule that must guide all our actions.

**Response to the Psalm:** O that today you would listen to my voice! "Harden not your hearts."

Alleluia, alleluia! God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. **Alleluia.**
