SUNDAY LITURGY

1st Reading: Sirach 27:30 – 28:7; 2nd Reading: Romans 14:7-9; Gospel: Matthew 18:21-35

Theme: Forgiveness Without Limit

The gospel of today is from the last part of chapter 18 which, as we saw last Sunday, deals with the problems of Matthew's communities and today emphasizes forgiveness. How should Christians deal with those who offend them? Should they retaliate? Not even once? Both the gospel passage and the first reading say clearly that the only possible Christian attitude is one of forgiveness. The second reading is connected to this; it recommends patience in dealing with those whose opinions are different from ours.

Response to the Psalm: The Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger, and rich in compassion."
