Theme: Not One Who Says, But One Who Does...

In the parable of the gospel we see two kinds of attitude among Christians today. To do the will of the Father does not mean performing religious rituals, but following the commandment of love. The first reading shows us the people of Israel in exile because they did not do the will of their father. The second reading uses another example, exactly the opposite of the first. Jesus does the will of his father unto death on the cross.

Last week the Fabric Committee met with the Quantity Surveyor and with the Diocesan Finance Director for an update on Church repairs. We also had a visit from two members of the Architect's group who were surveying the existing cracks and troubles in the church – both inside and out. We expect to have machinery and necessary equipment on site – on the garden – early next year. We need volunteers list and work on the safe storage of items within the church and moving the ashes of loved ones buried in our garden along the wall of the church.
